General Description:

BSA Hospital, located in Amarillo Texas is a 475 bed world-class facility with over 450 physicians and 2,700 employees. With the hospital's emphasis on a Christian environment, a new chapel and worship area has been constructed by Page & Associates of Amarillo. The chapel provides ministry via the CCTV system to the patient rooms several times daily. AMS designed an Audio/ Video system to provide a high quality video camera for the broadcasts. The chapel features twin motorized video screens with 4000 ANSI lumens video projectors. The main equipment rack houses all of the primary components including switching, playback, and control. A five inch AMX control panel provides total system control for all transports and power management. Two LCD televisions provide monitoring of the camera image. A seven inch monitor is built into the pulpit for a pre-view monitor.
